INTEGRATED TRAINING EXERCISE 3-17

MARINE CORPS AIR GROUND COMBAT CENTER TWENTYNINE PALMS, Calif. – Integrated Training Exercise 3-17 will take place aboard the Combat Center until June 2, 2017.

Integrated Training Exercise is a 29-day training evolution that focuses on the tactical application of combined-arms maneuver warfare during global contingency operations. It is decidedly kinetic in nature and returns readiness efforts to the core competencies assigned to the Marine Corps by public law and established defense strategy. ITX provides service-level assessments of battalion-size maneuver units and their associated combat support, combat service support and aviation assets, while conducting live fire training focused on the mission essential tasks of offensive, defensive and stability operations.
