Subj: FAMILY ADVOCACY COMMITTEE (FAC)

1. Situation. In accordance with the references, a multi-disciplinary group of individuals shall be established by the Commanding General (CG), Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command (MAGTFTC), Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (MCAGCC) to assist and advise the CG regarding management, coordination, and mobilization of resources for the Family Advocacy Program (FAP).

2. Mission. The primary goal of the FAC is to implement command awareness and prevention programs to educate all Marines.

3. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. This Bulletin in conjunction with the FAP will assist families experiencing the trauma of abuse.

(2) Concept of Operations. The FAC will advise on the Commanding General's FAP procedures, training, policy matters, program evaluation efforts, and will address the overall administrative details of the FAP.

b. Subordinate Element Missions

(1) The Chief of Staff will serve as the Chair to the FAC.

(2) Effective immediately the following personnel are appointed as primary members of the FAC:

(a) MAGTFTC, MCAGCC Command Sergeant Major.

(b) Staff Judge Advocate.

(c) Provost Marshal.

(d) Commanding Officer, Naval Hospital Twentynine Palms.

(e) Combat Center Chaplain.

(f) Marine and Family Program Director.

(g) Family Advocacy Program Manager (FAPM).

(h) Family Advocacy Prevention Specialist.

(i) Department of Defense Electronics A School Representative (if applicable).

(j) Other representatives as deemed appropriate by the FAPM.


(3) Should any of the primary members be unavoidably absent, the alternate will be identified in advance to the Chair of the FAC.
