Subj: PERMISSIVE TEMPORARY ADDITIONAL DUTY (PTAD) IN CONJUNCTION WITH FISCAL YEAR 2013 (FY13) REENLISTMENT


1. Situation. Per the references, PTAD may be used as a reenlistment incentive for FY13 First Term Alignment Plan (FTAP) and Subsequent Term Alignment Plan (STAP) Marines.
2. Mission. To establish policy and procedures for the FY13 FTAP and STAP PTAD reenlistment incentive.
3. Execution. Commanders are authorized to utilize the following retention incentive.
 - a. PTAD. Prepare PTAD orders using the format provided in the Defense Travel System or Marine On Line. This Bulletin will be cited as authorization. Maintain an accurate record of the orders issued and apply the following:
 - (1) First-term Marines reenlisting through the Total Force Retention System (TFRS) before 31 December 2012, may receive up to 14 days PTAD. First-term Marines reenlisting through TFRS after 1 January 2013, may receive up to seven days PTAD.
 - (2) Career Marines reenlisting during FY13 may receive up to seven days PTAD.
 - b. Marines have one year after the date of reenlistment to execute PTAD orders provided they remain under the Reenlistment Waiver Authority/General Court Marital Convening Authority of the Commanding General, Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command (MAGTFTC), Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (MCAGCC). Deployed Marines have 90 days following the deployment to execute PTAD orders. Marines executing permanent change of station/permanent change of assignment orders prior to taking PTAD may lose this incentive; they should be provided every opportunity to execute PTAD prior to departing their units.
4. Administration and Logistics. Distribution statement B directives issued by the Commanding General are distributed via e-mail upon request and can be viewed at <https://www.29palms.usmc.mil/dirs/adj/ccotoc.asp>.

DISTRIBUTION STATEMENT B: Distribution authorized only for MAGTFTC, MCAGCC directorates, special staff sections; less operational forces.

5. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Bulletin is applicable to all Marines under the Reenlistment Waiver Authority/General Court Marital Convening Authority of the Commanding General, MAGTF/TC, MCAGCC.

b. Signal. This Bulletin is effective the date signed.
