1. Situation. In accordance with the reference, service charges and usage fees for Bachelor Billeting and Billeting fund accommodations are reviewed annually to ensure operational expenses are met.

2. Mission. To publish service and rental charges for the use of transient quarters aboard the Combat Center under the management control of the Bachelor Billeting Division.

3. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. The Director, Bachelor Billeting, will ensure residents are informed of the service charge(s).

(2) Concept of Operations. The Director, Bachelor Billeting, will ensure endorsements for personnel residing in transient quarters contain the current service and rental charges.

b. Subordinate Element Mission. Commanding Officers, Assistant Chiefs of Staff, and Special Staff Officers will become familiar with the daily rates listed in the enclosure that are in effect from 1 October 2015 until 30 September 2016.
