1. Situation. The Combat Center conducts live-fire combined arms training that promotes readiness of operating forces and provides facilities, services, and support to the resident units, Marines, Sailors, and their families. In accordance with the references, it is essential that the Combat Center operate in a manner that is environmentally sound and in compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

2. Cancellation. CCO 5090.5B.

3. Mission. To establish instructions and procedures to manage hazardous, unregulated solid, recyclable, universal, and biological waste and material; and to establish policies and procedures in the areas of emergency preparedness and response and storage tank management aboard the Combat Center.

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. Commanding officers, Assistant Chiefs of Staff, Special Staff Officers, Officers-in-Charge, and contractors training and operating within the boundaries of the Combat Center shall comply with the provisions of this Order.

(2) Concept of Operations. The Director, Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs Division is responsible for the administration and management of the ICOP and will ensure that all operations conducted aboard the Combat Center are in compliance, in accordance with the references.

b. Subordinate Element Missions. All organizations, units, sections, and individuals living and working aboard the Combat Center will ensure compliance in accordance with the references and this Order.


c. Coordinating Instructions. Environmental compliance coordinators shall coordinate and integrate the environmental protection efforts outlined within the ICOP, reference (p), for their unit in accordance with the references.
