1. Situation. To implement the Marine Corps Comprehensive Environmental Training and Education Program (CETEP) for Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command (MAGTFTC), Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (MCAGCC).

2. Cancellation. CCO 5090.2.

3. Mission. All MAGTFTC, MCAGCC personnel will receive environmental training, instruction, and information as required per reference (a).

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. To develop, maintain, and implement a CETEP plan that addresses environmental training requirements. Personnel will actively support, implement, and manage the CETEP plan per policies, procedures, and guidance set forth in references (a) and (b).

(2) Concept of Operations. The CETEP plan, in reference (b), documents and describes decisions made to ensure appropriate environmental training and information are provided to all targeted personnel. It also provides a detailed description of the impact of environmental training and requirements for the Combat Center's programs and procedures established to address overall Marine Corps readiness, pollution prevention, quality of life, and environmental compliance goals.

b. Subordinate Element Missions

(1) Commanders, Assistant Chiefs of Staff (AC/S), Directors, Officers in Charge (OIC), and Action Sponsors. Ensure compliance with this Order and the policies contained in the references.

(2) Assistant Chief of Staff G-3. Ensure that all units training at the Combat Center adhere to this Order and the references.

(3) Assistant Chief of Staff G-4

(a) Is delegated the responsibility for recommending policies and producing an instructions manual for complying with the CETEP plan.

(b) Ensure that the CETEP plan instructions manual is reviewed annually, complies with higher level directives and is available for all activities to utilize.

(c) The Natural Resource and Environmental Affairs office will assign a CETEP coordinator to develop, maintain, and implement a CETEP plan to meet the program requirements.

c. Coordinating Instructions

(1) Comply with applicable environmental training and education standards.


(2) The CETEP Instruction Manual can be viewed utilizing reference (b). Click on "Documents", then click on "CETEP Instruction Manual".
