1. Situation. The Commanding General (CG), Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command, Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center is responsible for the health and physical readiness of those in his command in accordance with the references.

2. Cancellation. CCO 6260.2E.

3. Mission. To provide information about the health care needs and evaluate the health care requirements, expectations, and perceptions of the active duty, retired, and family members of the Combat Center community and to comply with the standards in reference (b).

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. The CG utilizes the Commanding General's Readiness meeting and Family Readiness Officer's (FRO) meeting to ensure enhanced and enabled communication with health care consumers concerning health care support.

(2) Concept of Operations

(a) To provide health care consumers with an effective means of presenting their views concerning the operation of the health care delivery system.

(b) To provide the health care provider a forum to increase the understanding of the health care system for health care consumers.

(c) To allow the views of health care consumers to be considered in major decisions that affect the availability of health care.

b. Subordinate Element Missions

(1) Commanding Officers

(a) Please provide representation to the Base Readiness Meeting.

(b) Ensure that the name, work number, unit, email address, and building number where the FRO is assigned is provided to the Command Customer Relations Officer at (760) 830-2475, Naval Hospital, Twentynine Palms.


- (a) Provide representation at the Base Readiness Meeting.
