Subj: TWENTYNINE PALMS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FALL FESTIVAL

1. Situation. The Commanding General, Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command (MAGTFTC), Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (MCAGCC) has directed the Assistant Chief of Staff (AC/S) G-5, Community Plans and Liaison Office to support the Twentynine Palms Elementary School Fall Festival on 5 November 2015.

2. Mission. To publish information and instructions for the support of the Twentynine Palms Elementary School Fall Festival.

3. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. To maintain positive relations between the Combat Center and the citizens of the Morongo Basin.

(2) Concept of Operations. Contingent on operational management, support the Twentynine Palms Elementary School Fall Festival by providing personnel and equipment.

b. Subordinate Element Missions

(1) AC/S G-3, Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD). Request an EOD Demonstration for this event.

(2) AC/S G-5, Public Affairs Office. Request appropriate media coverage for this event.

c. Coordinating Instructions

(1) The Coordinating Officer for this event is Shannon Ackerman at (760) 830-3738, cell (571) 289-5257, sackerman@marstel-day.com, or shannon.ackerman.ctr@usmc.mil.

(2) On 5 November 2015, Marines participating in the EOD Demonstration will travel from the Combat Center to the Twentynine Palms Elementary School at 74350 Playa Vista Drive, Twentynine Palms, CA 92277. Once there, the Marines will stage their demonstration for the event. Once the event concludes, they will return to the Combat Center.

(3) The senior member of the unit will call the Command Duty Officer both when departing and returning to the base at (760) 830-7200.

(4) Timeline for 5 November 2015

1625 - Depart the Combat Center.
1645 - EOD and personnel arrive to Twentynine Palms Elementary School.
1650 - Stage EOD Demonstration.
1730 - Event begins.
1800 - EOD Demonstration.
1930 - Event concludes. EOD and personnel depart for Combat Center.
2000 - EOD arrives at Combat Center, mission complete.

(5) Uniforms for the Event

(a) The Unit participating in the EOD Demonstration will be in the seasonal Marine Pattern (MARPAT) Marine Corps Combat Utility Uniform (MCCUU).


(b) The spirit and intent of the Commandant of the Marine Corps guidance for wearing uniforms off base will be strictly adhered to. No MARPAT MCCUU will be worn in a liberty status. However, it is understood that the Marines driving tactical vehicles for static displays and parades will be in the seasonal MARPAT MCCUU. These Marines will stay next to their vehicles and will be briefed that they are not in a liberty status. As such, they will conduct themselves professionally, promoting the positive image of the United States Marine Corps. The senior Marine participating will be responsible for ensuring the intent of wearing the MARPAT uniform during this event is met and will establish guidelines for stops, if necessary (head calls, chow runs, etc.).

5. Command and Signal
