Subj: PARK TO PARK RIDE AND FESTIVAL

1. Situation. The Commanding General, Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command (MAGTFTC), Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (MCAGCC) has directed the Assistant Chief of Staff (AC/S) G-5, Community Plans and Liaison Office to support the Park to Park Ride and Festival on 30 April 2016.

(2) On 30 April 2016, G-4 support participating in the Park to Park Ride and Festival will travel from the Combat Center to the staging area at Knott Sky Park located at 6897 El Sol Avenue, Twentynine Palms, CA 92277 arriving at approximately 0900. Once there, support will set up for the event at the pre-designated locations. Once the event is over, all supporting personnel and equipment will return to the Combat Center.

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(3) Timeline for 30 April 2016


0845 - Support participating in this event will depart the Combat Center
