Subj: LANDERS 3RD OF JULY INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

1. Situation. The Commanding General, Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command (MAGTFTC), Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (MCAGCC) has directed the Assistant Chief of Staff G-5, Government and External Affairs Office, to support the 3rd of July Independence Day Celebration.

2. Mission. To publish information and instructions for the support of the 3rd of July Independence Day Celebration.

3. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. To maintain positive relations between the Combat Center and the citizens of the Morongo Basin; MAGTFTC, MCAGCC has, contingent on operational management, agreed to provide personnel and equipment to support this event.

(2) Concept of Operations. By providing this service to the community, the units participating in this event will provide the local residents an opportunity to learn about the vehicles and personnel stationed aboard the Combat Center.

b. Subordinate Element Missions

(a) Assistant Chief Staff G-5, Public Affairs. Provide appropriate media coverage.

(b) MAGTFTC, MCAGCC Color Sergeant. Provide a color guard to participate in the ceremony.

(c) I Marine Expeditionary Force (I MEF) Support. Request rolling stock vehicles with a static display; participate in this event as designated by I MEF.

b. Coordinating Instructions

(2) On 3 July 2016, Marines participating in the Landers 3rd of July Independence Day Celebration will travel from the Combat Center to Homestead Valley Park, 1501 Belfield Blvd, Landers, CA. Upon arrival at 1430, the

Marines providing the static display will set up in the staging area. The event will begin at 1600. Once the event concludes, the Marines will return to the Combat Center.

(3) The senior member of each unit will call the MAGTFTC, MCAGCC Command Duty Officer both when departing and returning to the base at (760) 830-7200.

(4) Timeline for 3 July 2016

TBD - Depart the Combat Center
1430 - Arrive at Homestead Valley Park for static display staging
1600 - Celebration begins
1800 - Color Guard arrive/check-in
1900 - Color Guard to present the Colors
2000 - Fireworks Display
2045 - Celebration concludes, return to Combat Center
TBD - Arrive at the Combat Center

(5) Uniforms for the Event

(a) Units participating in the rolling stock will be in the seasonal Marine pattern (MARPAT) Marine Corps Combat Utility Uniform.

(b) The spirit and intent of wearing uniforms off base will strictly adhere to the Commandant of the Marine Corps' guidance. No MARPAT uniform will be worn in a liberty status. It is understood that the Marines driving tactical vehicles for static displays and parades will be in the MARPAT seasonal uniform. These Marines will stay next to their vehicles and will be briefed that they are not in a liberty status. As such, they will conduct themselves professionally, promoting the positive image of the United States Marine Corps. The senior Marine participating will be responsible for ensuring the intent of wearing the MARPAT uniform during this event is met, and will establish guidelines for stops of necessity (head calls, chow runs, etc.).


(c) The senior Marine participating will be designated by the I MEF Task order.
