

Bus Pass Q and A's

How much are bus passes?

Full price	\$100.00 per half year 1st child \$ 50.00 per half year 2nd child Free for 3rd or more children
Reduced	\$25.00 per half year 1st child \$10.00 per half year 2nd child Free for 3rd or more children
Free	\$0.00 (Free and reduced passes require submission of the qualification letter from nutritional service with the bus pass application.)

Do we get our stops back that were taken away?

I'm sorry, the increase in walking distances and stop reductions were/are another way we've reduced bussing costs and we're unable to re-instate cancelled stops.

Is the School District making a profit on this?

No, school busing is funded by the state of California, but it's not fully funded by the state. In Fact funding for busing has been severely cut. Bus pass sales will only put a small dent in the unfunded costs which take money right out of the classroom.

If my student only rides one way do I get a pass at ½ price?

We are charging a pass to use the bus system, not for individual bus rides. The bus pass is good to ride the bus anytime your student needs to.

What if my student only rides rarely?

Your school administrators can give your student a bus note to ride the bus on those limited occasions.

So you think we can really afford this?

Careful consideration was given to charging for bus service and the rates we have set are comparable if not much less than other "like" districts which are charging for busing.

What happens if my student doesn't have a pass?

Students who have lost a bus pass will be given five days to obtain a replacement, contact Transportation. Replacement passes are \$8.00. Student who refuse to obtain a bus pass will receive a bus referral each day they board the bus without a pass, the referrals will follow the basic discipline matrices.
