March sets focus on **Shoplifting**. Removing an item from a store without purchasing is shoplifting. Sometimes you may feel strapped for funds, but that does not give you a reason to steal.

Ways to prevent shoplifting are:

Use a basket or shopping cart. Do not place merchandise in your pocket.

Double check your shopping cart for forgotten merchandise before you check out.

If you see someone who may be shoplifting, report it to an employee & do not intervene.

If you have kids, teach them the importance of integrity. Keep an eye on them to ensure they do not snag small items (i.e. gum, candy, soda).

If you know something is not affordable, do not entertain the thought of stealing merchandise. It is not worth a criminal record or fine.

Shoplifting can happen by accident or by choice.

Don't be a shoplifting statistic.
