

## Who Can Attend TLog?

TLog is open to:

- Commissioned officers, who must be O3 or above; have completed a company command; and have completed or been awarded constructive credit for branch advanced courses.
- Department of the Army civilians.
- Others may be admitted by exception.

## Earn a Master's Degree From Florida Tech!

TLog and Florida Institute of Technology (FIT) participate in a **cooperative degree program** that grants equivalency credits toward a master's degree in logistics, logistics management, or disaster management. TLog graduates can transfer 12 graduate credit hours to FIT. Military students who PCS stay and complete their entire degree within one year.

## Theater Logistics Planners Program (TLog)


The Theater Logistics Planners Program is the tool the Army has created for developing world-class planners in response to Army service component-level commands asking for sustainment planners with increased operational knowledge, honed decision-making abilities, and refined staff skills capable of leveraging strategic agencies while planning at the theater and expeditionary sustainment command levels.

TLog graduates [after completing a 19-week resident program] come ready to provide general officers and senior-level commands with agile, innovative logistical staff officers capable of preparing sustainment plans, including strategic partner reach back, to meet any crisis or deliberate Army action.

Graduates of TLog arrive at your command armed with the skill, ability, and capacity to find solutions for complex operational logistics challenges by leveraging theater logistics synergy in support of the war fighter, including sister services and coalition partners.

### TLog graduates can –

- Work in today's Joint Operating Environment to apply key components of planning actions.
- Create sustainment plans and orders that match combat plans and operations.
- Incorporate strategic organizations and contractors into theater logistics plans.
- Recognize and effectively solve problems.
- Demonstrate viable staff skills expected of a member of a general officer's staff.
