I FURTHER DECLARE that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by my said attorney-in-fact shall be binding on myself and my heirs, legal and personal representatives and assigns, whether the same shall have been done either before or after my death, or other revocation of this instrument, unless and until reliable intelligence or notice thereof shall have been received by my said attorney-in-fact; and whether or not I, the grantor of this instrument, shall have been reported or listed, either officially or otherwise, as "missing in action" as that phrase is used in military parlance, or as "captured," it being my intent that such status designation shall not bar my attorney-in-fact from fully and completely exercising and continuing to exercise any and all powers and rights herein granted and that such report of "missing in action" or "captured" shall neither constitute nor be interpreted as constituting notice of my death nor operate to revoke this instrument.

FURTHER, this power of attorney shall remain in full force and

effect until the ____ day of ____ ____, 20___, unless sooner revoked by me. To induce any third party to act hereunder, I hereby agree that any third party receiving a duly executed copy or facsimile of this power of attorney may act hereunder, and that revocation or termination hereof shall be ineffective as to such third party unless and until actual notice or knowledge of such revocation or partial or complete termination of this power of attorney by adjudication of incapacity, suspension by initiation of proceedings to determine incapacity, or my death shall have been received by such third party in accordance with the requirements of law. I, for myself and my heirs, executors, legal representatives and assigns, hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless any such third party from and against any and all claims that may arise against such third party by reason of such third party having relied upon the

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provisions of this power of attorney, and provided further, that in the event that I should be reported or listed "missing" or "missing in action", as those phrases are used in military parlance, prior to the expiration or revocation of this power of attorney, it shall not terminate but shall be extended as long as I remain in that status. It is my intention that such status designation shall not bar my attorney-in-fact from fully and completely exercising and continuing to exercise any and all powers and rights herein granted, and that such report of "missing" or "missing in action" shall neither constitute nor be interpreted as constituting notice of my death, nor operate to revoke this instrument.

This **DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY** shall not be affected by my subsequent disability or incapacity, and that notwithstanding any termination date herein, or lapse of time, and that in the event of my subsequent disability or incapacity prior to the expiration or revocation of this power of attorney, it shall not terminate but shall be extended as long as I remain in that status. It is my intent that the authority conferred herein shall be exercisable not withstanding my physical disability or mental incapacity or incompetence.
