1. Situation. The Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command (MAGTFTC), Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (MCAGCC) provides a wide variety of facilities, services, and support. The G-4, Public Works Division (PWD) is assigned responsibility to provide facilities support to tenant organizations aboard the Combat Center.

2. Cancellation. CCO 4100.3D, CCO 11014.1C, CCO 11100.1D, and CCO 11300.4B.

3. Mission. To promulgate local policies and standard operating procedures for the receipt of timely facilities maintenance and engineering services from the PWD, in compliance with references (a) through (h).

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. To provide the highest quality of life aboard the Combat Center by efficiently utilizing the support services available through the PWD.

(2) Concept of Operations. MAGTFTC, MCAGCC organizations and tenant units will efficiently utilize the support services of the PWD by adhering to local policies and procedures as detailed in reference (h). PWD is responsible for all construction, repairs, alterations, site approvals, dig permits, and other work that affects property, buildings, facilities, utilities, and infrastructure. MAGTFTC, MCAGCC organizations and tenant units shall ensure that a proper state of operation, maintenance, and repair exists for their assigned facilities and facilities related equipment.

b. Subordinate Element Missions

(a) Commanding Officers (CO), Assistant Chiefs of Staff (AC/S), Officers In Charge (OIC), and Directors. COs, AC/S, OICs, and Directors shall ensure compliance with this Order and the policies contained in the references. To relax any of the criteria in the references requires approval from the Commanding General (CG), MAGTF/TC, MCAFCC.

(b) Assistant Chief of Staff G-4, Installations and Logistics

(1) The AC/S G-4 will review local policies and establish standard operating procedures (SOP) for the acquisition, management, and maintenance of facilities and structures aboard the Combat Center.


(2) The AC/S G-4 will ensure that the PWD SOP is reviewed annually, complies with higher level directives contained in the references, and is available for units to utilize in order to allow timely access to PWD support.
