1. Situation. Per the reference, the Headquarters Marine Corps, Manpower Management Officer Assignment (MMA) representatives will visit the Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command (MAGTF), Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (MCAGCC) on 25 September 2026, to afford Marine officers the opportunity to have direct, personal communication with their respective occupational field monitor for career counseling and/or potential future assignments.

2. Mission. To publish information and assign execution responsibilities for the upcoming fiscal year 2027 (FY27) MMA Roadshow visit.

3. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. To ensure all officers can attend the Manpower & Reserve Affairs (M&RA) Manpower briefing and participate in the scheduled Town Hall breakout sessions with the respective MMA teams as noted in enclosure (1).

(2) Concept of Operations. MMA will visit the Combat Center to brief all available Marine officers on assignment policies, procedures, promotion and retention information, career patterns, and other items which could affect their career.

b. Subordinate Element Tasks

(1) Commanders, Assistant Chiefs of Staff (ACs/S), Division Directors, Special Staff Officers, and Officers-in-Charge

(a) On 25 September 2026, ensure all available officers attend the M&RA manpower briefs. Interview scheduling instructions are provided in paragraph 4.b. of this Letter of Instruction (LOI) to schedule a one-on-one interview appointment with Marine Officer's respective monitor.

(b) Ensure that members of your command are seated 15 minutes prior to the start time of the designated session. Each command is responsible for their personnel accountability.

(2) AC/S, G-1

(a) G-1 shall coordinate all aspects of the visit.

(b) Schedule in calls for the senior MMOA visiting official, to include an office call with the MAGTF/TC, MCAGCC Commanding General, Chief of Staff, and AC/S, G-1 to discuss key billet holders that are projected to transfer within the next year.

(c) Coordinate audio/visual equipment support as requested in the reference.

(3) AC/S, G-7

(a) Publicize the visit.

(b) Include the MMOA visit in the speed calls and radio broadcasts.

(4) AC/S, Marine Corps Community Services

(a) Ensure the Base Marquee advertises the upcoming MMOA visit.

(b) Ensure that the Table Two Nine (formerly O'Club) Mesa Room and main dining area, Bldg 1573, are ready to accommodate the MMOA Town Halls.

(c) Ensure that the Base Theater, Bldg 1510, is ready to accommodate the MMOA Manpower briefs at 0800 on 25 September 2026.

(d) Ensure all audio/visual equipment is operational and ready for use. Provide an employee who is experienced in operating the audio/visual equipment and can open the theater for setup, no later than 0730, 25 September 2026.

(5) Director, Tactical Training Exercise Control Group (TTECG). Ensure TTECG's classrooms are prepared to host Combat Arms Town Halls.

4. Administration and Logistics

b. Interview Scheduling. MMOA monitors will publish their individual interview schedules via their respective websites. Access instructions for the interview will be provided via the Talent Management Engagement Platform. Priority for interviews will be given to FY27 movers.

5. Command and Signal
