Subj: PROCEDURES FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

- 1. $\underline{\text{Situation}}$. People are an integral and essential asset to the mission of the Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command (MAGTFTC), Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (MCAGCC). The Command is dedicated to safeguarding our personnel and ensuring proper and prompt emergency medical services.
- 2. Cancellation. CCO 6400.1K.
- 3. $\underline{\text{Mission}}$. In accordance with the references, this Order outlines the procedures for Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and "First Responder" responsibilities.

4. Execution

- a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations
- (1) <u>Commander's Intent</u>. Commanding Officers, Assistant Chiefs of Staff, Special Staff Officers, Division Directors, and Officers-in-Charge will ensure they are familiar with and comply with this Order.
- (2) <u>Concept of Operations</u>. EMS will be established in accordance with reference (a). EMS will be provided aboard the Combat Center per this Order.
 - b. Subordinate Element Missions
 - (1) Director, Mission Assurance
 - (a) Combat Center Fire Department (CCFD)
- $\underline{1}$. Ensure all CCFD personnel who provide pre-hospital emergency medical care possess the Inland County Emergency Medical Agency (ICEMA) accreditation or certification per reference (b).
- 2. Provide care, treatment, and transportation of injured personnel to the most appropriate medical facility.
 - $\underline{3}$. Ensure personnel assigned as ambulance drivers possess

appropriate drivers licenses and a Navy Safety Center Emergency Vehicle Operator Certificate.

- $\underline{4}$. Contact the appropriate Medical Direction when treating and transporting a patient to a receiving facility. Medical Direction will notify the receiving facility of the arrival and patient status.
- $\underline{5}$. Provide the Electronic Patient Care Report to the receiving facility to ensure proper transfer of patient care.
- $\underline{6}$. All refusals of service shall follow ICEMA protocols and proper documentation shall be performed.
- $\underline{7}$. Ensure Combat Center ambulances are maintained in a ready status at all times, per reference (b).
- $\underline{8}$. First arriving CCFD officer on-scene will function as the Incident Commander. Combat Center Fire shall maintain scene/medical authority until the scene is released to the Provost Marshal's Office (PMO).

(b) PMO

- $\underline{\textbf{1}}$. Shall be prepared to function within the Incident Command System and/or assume command on non-FIRE/EMS incidents.
- $\underline{2}$. Activate the Enhanced 911 (E911) process whenever an emergency call is received by PMO through any other source other than the MCAGCC E911 Dispatch Center.

(2) Naval Hospital Twentynine Palms

- (a) Shall support the Combat Center Fire pre hospital EMS program per reference (c).
- (b) Receive all Advanced Life Support patients unless resources are fully committed per reference (b). Basic Life Support (BLS) ambulance or any units with a BLS patient will not be diverted, per reference (b).
- (3) <u>Assistant Chief of Staff, G-6 Communications</u>. Shall continue to support the Combat Center Emergency Communications Center 9-1-1 system and the emergency (760) 830-3333 via cell line.
- (4) Organizations and Section Heads. Ensure their personnel are familiar with and comply with this Order.
- 5. <u>Administration and Logistics</u>. Directives issued by this Headquarters are published and distributed electronically. Electronic versions of Combat Center directives can be found at https://www.29palms.marines.mil/Staff-Offices/G-1-Manpower-Directorate/Adjutant/#combat-center-orders.

6. Command and Signal

- a. <u>Command</u>. This Order is applicable to all commands, organizations, and individuals working and living aboard the Combat Center.
 - b. Signal. This Order is effective the date signed.
