- <u>Strategic Location Incentive Program (SLIP)</u>. Per MARADMIN 470/24, SLIP is an initiative for career enlisted Marines who accept orders to difficult to fill billets in exchange for an agreed upon duty station preference for the following tour.
- Education, Exercises, and Training Opportunities. Our world-class MAGTFTC MCAGCC education, exercise, and training opportunities provide target rich environments to recruit. We start individual and group conversations and share information with those that thrive at MAGTFTC MCAGCC. We build time into our course introductions and end of course critiques to share MAGTFTC MCAGCC opportunities, answer questions, and encourage Marines to work with their monitors to join MAGTFTC MCAGCC in the future.
- Partnerships. We partner with Manpower and Reserve Affairs, Manpower Management (MM), Officer Assignments (MMOA), Enlisted Assignments (MMEA), and Marine Corps Forces Reserve (MARFORRES) to meet our requirements. We tap into our occupational communities of practices, message boards, Microsoft Teams channels, working groups, etc. to share opportunities. We encourage Marines to contact their monitors and discuss possible career options (e.g., low-cost permanent change of station (PCS), no cost permanent change of assignment (PCA) orders, voluntary time on station extension requests, etc.).
