POLICY LETTER 2-20

Subj: COVID-19 RELATED ACTIONS FOR PERSONNEL TRAINING ABOARD THE MARINE  
CORPS AIR GROUND COMBAT CENTER

1. Purpose. To comply with the references, this policy letter provides guidance regarding the handling of personnel with COVID-19 symptoms while training aboard the Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command (MAGTFTC), Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (MCAGCC), Twentynine Palms, California.

2. Information. Given the facility limitations of the MCAGCC Medical Isolation and Observation Center (MIOC) relative to the exercise population, it is necessary for I MEF exercise forces from Camp Pendleton to return any personnel to their parent command who become ill during the exercise. All other military exercise participants not residents of MCAGCC will be placed in the MCAGCC MIOC if they present COVID-19 symptoms and require testing.

a. All military exercise participants that have COVID-19 symptoms confirmed by a medical officer, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, or Independent Duty Corpsman will be placed in a Restriction of Movement (ROM) status for 14 days per reference (c).


b. Transportation to the Adult Medical Care Clinic for testing is a unit's responsibility. I MEF personnel not assigned to a MAGTFTC, MCAGCC unit that are unable to be transported back to home station during normal business hours, will reside overnight in the MCAGCC MIOC and be transported to their home station the next day. MAGTFTC, MCAGCC military personnel will be placed in the MCAGCC MIOC or returned to their barracks/home residence after getting tested per the enclosure. Preventive Medicine will conduct contact tracing for individuals who test positive for COVID-19.

c. This policy applies to all units training aboard the Combat Center for the duration of the COVID-19 response effort and will be adjusted as requirements change.
