- (P) Put consent to practice. (Consent is an enthusiastic Yes from both partners)
- (R) React and intervene when you see something. (Know what "red flags" to watch for, from both a victim and perpetrator)
- (E) Exercise self-control. (Respect someone's NO and know that what people may wear is not an invitation)
- (V) Value your choices. (Let your value drive your choices in your decision-making process)
- (E) Encourage victims to report. (Know where to direct people for proper reporting procedures)
- (N) Never find yourself in situations which may lead to bad choices. (Know that alcohol does not give anyone a right to think Yes is the answer)
- (T) Teach your family, children, and friends the importance of sexual assault prevention and reporting.
