- (P) Put consent to practice. *(Consent is an enthusiastic Yes from both partners)*
  - (R) React and intervene when you see something. *(Know what "red flags" to watch for, from both a victim and perpetrator)*
  - (E) Exercise self-control. *(Respect someone's NO and know that what people may wear is not an invitation)*
  - (V) Value your choices. *(Let your value drive your choices in your decision-making process)*
  - (E) Encourage victims to report. *(Know where to direct people for proper reporting procedures)*
  - (N) Never find yourself in situations which may lead to bad choices. *(Know that alcohol does not give anyone a right to think Yes is the answer)*
  - (T) Teach your family, children, and friends the importance of sexual assault prevention and reporting.
