Crime Prevention is an active program that combines public awareness & preventive measures to reduce crime.

The focus for the month of April is **Sexual Assault Awareness and Prevention**. During April people will join efforts in preventing sexual assault through different community events. Help us with the following preventive measures:

Place consent into practice, which is an affirmative “Yes” from both partners

React and intervene when you see something and know the “Red Flags” to watch for from a victim or perpetrator

Exercise self-control and respect to someone’s “No” and always remember choice of clothing worn is **NOT** an open invitation

Value your choices and let your value drive your thoughts in your decision-making process

Encourage victims to report in the manner they choose by knowing who to direct them to for help

Never put yourself in a situation which may lead to a bad choice and remember alcohol use does **NOT** create a “Yes”

Teach your unit, family, children, and friends the importance of sexual assault prevention and reporting.
