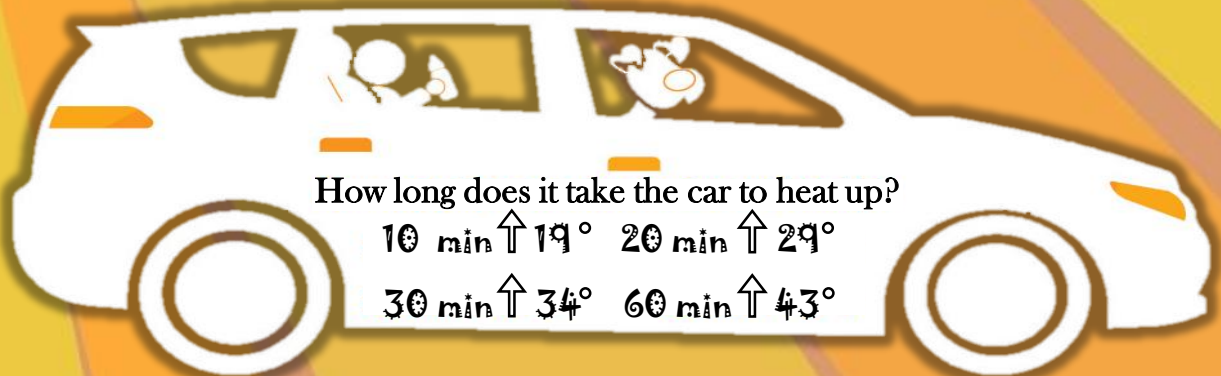
Crime Prevention is an active program that combines public awareness & preventive measures to reduce crime.

Focus for the month of August finishes the **Summer Awareness** series. Heat can be awful in the summer as the sun melts us. Even though we are near summer's end precautions are still required. This is how to **ACT** in prevention of heat stroke accidents:

Avoid leaving children or animals in the car alone, even for a minute.

Create a reminder by placing items needed upon arrival at your destination in the backseat next to your child or pet.
