Ask permission prior to sending explicit messages or texts.

Whether you are online or offline, connect with respect.

Intervene when you see harmful content and behaviors.

Promote online communities that value respect, inclusion, and safety.

Protect children from the dangers of online exploitation.

Remember virtual harassment can leave lasting harm, as the content is often public, inerasable, and just as emotionally damaging as in-person. Join advocates, survivors, and supporters by getting involved and participate in the #30DaysOfSAAM.
