The focus for this month is **Driving Awareness!** Did you know there is etiquette rules when driving? Have you practiced those rules? Need a reminder of those rules? GREAT, here it is:

## **Maintain a Safe Following Distance**

*Tailgating is dangerous and disrespectful, so try to follow the 3-second rule.*

## **Check Your Surrounding Before Parking/Leaving a Parking Spot**

*Avoid damage to other vehicles due to improper parking habits*

**Monitor the Use of Your High Beams** - *Use high beams only when necessary & dim them when other drivers are in sight.*

## **Always Use a Turn Signal**

*Signals are an informative action for other drivers to know your intentions, so use them.*

## **Watch Your Speed**

*Speeding is dangerous but going too slow is also. Follow the posted speeds to keep the traffic flow safe!*

**Reduce Driving Distractions** - *Not only is using a cellphone without hands-free illegal, but also a large cause to accidents. Be sure to use hands-free devices and limit any other distractions (eating, shaving, make-up application, etc.)*
