## Maintain a Safe Following Distance

Tailgating is dangerous and disrespectful, so try to follow the 3-second rule.

Check Your Surrounding Before
Parking/Leaving a Parking Spot
Avoid damage to other vehicles
due to improper parking habits

Monitor the Use of Your High Beams - Use high beams only when necessary & dim them when other drivers are in sight.

## Always Use a Turn Signal

Signals are an informative action for other drivers to know your intentions, so use them.

## Watch Your Speed

Speeding is dangerous but going too slow is also.
Follow the posted speeds to keep the traffic flow safe!

Reduce Driving Distractions - Not only is using a cellphone without hands-free illegal, but also a large cause to accidents. Be sure to use hands-free devices and limit any other distractions (eating, shaving, make-up application, etc.)
