The focus for this month continues **Summertime Crime!** Heat is awful as the sun shines ever bright during summer months. Help prevent heat injuries by remembering to ACT:

void leaving children or animals in the hot car alone, even but for a minute as the car heats up quicker than you know.

reate reminders by placing needed items in the backseat next to your child or pet.

ake action if you see children or animals left alone in a hot car by calling 9-1-1 (off-base) and 760-830-3333 (on-base).

ACTing can be used for other great safety tips in the summer such as:

Apply sunscreen to help Avoid skin cancer.

Place water throughout your home to Create a reminder to stay hydrated.

Use a fan to Take action for cool air circulation.

Wear hats and sunglasses to Avoid constant sun contact.

Carry an umbrella to Create shade for yourself, children, and pets.

Take action on the seriousness of heat injury prevention.

Simply ACTing allows you to prevent heat injuries but also ways to avoid crime leading to greater issues. The Provost Marshal urges you to follow all preventive measures and always remember to ACT! Stay Safe! Stay Shaded!
