Crime Prevention is an active program that combines public awareness & prevention measures to reduce crime

**May** sets focus on **School Violence Prevention**. School violence incidents have occurred in past decades and recent months. Regardless if you are a parent, teacher, counselor, or student, use these prevention actions:

**Report it:** Report any hints of violent behaviors to school authorities.

**Inform Adults:** Children witnessing/experiencing violence must tell adults (parents, teachers, and counselors) until someone does something.

**Reach Out to People:** Reach out to bullied children, those who are bullying & any other child, especially those with signs of anxiety/depression, or trouble managing emotions.

**Watch for Warning Signs:** Be attentive for warning signs of violence, which includes talking/playing with weapons, harming pets, bullying others, watching violent movies, and speaking aggressively.

These are only a few actions available. Be aware of different risk factors (poor academic performance, dysfunctional family dynamic, delinquency, etc.) associated with school violence, but know violence is not only caused by these occurrences/behaviors.

Be there, report it, and support children!
