July sets focus on **Scams and Frauds**. Scammers lure people through various schemes. Generally, they include hijacked business/job ads, senior Marine impersonators & fake relief funds. Avoid these scams by:

Verifying job openings before you apply.

Do not allow contact from any unknown "Marines" posed as senior enlisted.

Never give bank information to anyone you don't know and avoid paying upfront in exchange for promises.

Know legit people will never contact you out of the blue demanding money or information.

Never pay anyone via cryptocurrency, gift cards, or wire transfer.

Think smart before scammers or frauds try to illegally take your money. Keep an eye out for common trends & always research online. If you have been scammed, think you are currently being scammed, or need assistance, contact the local CID office at (760) 830-6820.
