May 2024 brings focus on **Bicycle Safety**.

It is National Bicycle Safety Month & the Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) urges bicyclists & motorists to share roads while abiding by traffic laws & respecting rights. Regardless of riding skill, laws exist for safety. Here are basic rules, regulations & standard practices:

**Bicyclists must follow the same traffic rules & regulations as motorists.**

**Bicyclists shall wear helmets regardless of age.**

**Bicyclists will ride on the right edge of the road with the flow of traffic.**

**Bicyclists must use headlights & rear reflectors when riding in the dark.**

**Bicyclists are encouraged to secure bicycles when unattended by use of locks.**



The safety of bicyclists is important & sharing the road must be performed. By not following guidelines & laws you are subject to citation. Ensure all NHTSA guidelines are adhered to when riding on or off the base.
