

# FIREARM SAFETY AND GUIDELINES

## Storage/Transportation Requirement:

***Firearms must be stored in an enclosed container (hard plastic case, commercial safe, etc.) able to be locked.***

*Firearms are not authorized for storage in a BEQ for E-1 to E-5, but must be stored in a unit armory or off-base.*

***SNCOs and Officers are authorized storage in BEQ/BOQ with the proper container.***

*Firearms are not authorized to be stored in a privately-owned vehicle.*

***Firearms must be transported on safe and unloaded, as well as in a locked container within the trunk, when no trunk exists it must be inaccessible from the driver.***

*Concealed firearms are prohibited aboard the Combat Center, except when transiting from housing to the gate while in your vehicle and if permitted to carry a concealed firearm in the State of California.*

***All regulations must be followed. For questions contact the Provost Marshal's Office.***

## Registration Requirement:

*A firearm must be registered to the Combat Center prior to introduction.*

***Personnel who live in housing aboard the Combat Center must register their firearms.***

*Personnel who live in BEQ/BOQ aboard the Combat Center must register their firearms.*

***Additionally, underwater spear guns, air pistols/rifles firing pellets, BBs, or darts must be registered.***

*Firearms stored off the Combat Center (Vista Del Sol Housing Complex, private housing, etc.) must be registered in accordance with the State of California regulations.*

***Shotguns, rifles, and pistols introduced for marksmanship activities need not to be registered but must be removed the same day.***
