



# Make a Plan before leaving on Vacation!



If you must leave any keys behind, make sure they are kept with a trustworthy and responsible person.

Replace any broken door, gate, and garage locks.

Do not hide house keys anywhere they can be easily obtained by anyone that should not have them.



If possible, have a house sitter look after your home, instead of leaving it vacant.

Except for the funds you are taking, deposit all cash into the bank and avoid leaving it at home.



If you are leaving the state or the country, take extra precaution to secure other valuables in a safe place.

Never leave important documents, money, valuables, credit cards, etc. out in the open for view.



Ensure there are no vulnerable areas around the house to break in.

Notify the Military Police or local police to check your house on occasion.

Most importantly, ensure the outside is well lit and all blinds are closed.

Do not post anything on social media regarding you being away from the home.
