1. Situation. To promulgate policy for administering the authorization of Basic Allowance for Subsistence for enlisted Marines assigned to Headquarters Battalion (HQBN).
2. Mission. To issue policy for the management, operation, and administration of Basic Allowance for Subsistence (BAS) for enlisted personnel assigned to HQBN. Beginning immediately, all Marines assigned to HQBN who do not meet the requirements per the references and this order will not be authorized BAS. This will be done in order to promote mess hall usage, to prevent unqualified BAS authorization, and to improve the nutrition and personal financial management of individual Marines. Strict compliance with the references will be adhered to.
3. Summary of Change. Enclosure (1) has been updated to accurately reflect the sections and billets within HQBN that are authorized to receive BAS in accordance with the references.

Subj: ISSUE ON TACTICAL TRAINING AND EXERCISE CONTROL GROUP MARINES AND
COMMUTED RATIONS

Ref: (a) CCO 10110.13C
(b) BnO 10110.1H Ch 1

1. Reference (a) requires enlisted members to meet one of the four listed categories in in paragraph 4.a(2)(b) in order to be eligible to receive commuted rations (COMRATS).
2. The Marines and Sailors of Tactical Training and Exercise Control Group are the primary observers and exercise controllers for the five to six Service Level Training Exercises (SLTE) that occur every year on Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center (MCAGCC). SLTE fully encompasses every section within TTECG, as every Marine and Sailor is on call and expected to be at their workplace or in the field outside of normal working business hours, in order to support the exercises forces. The majority of this training occurs throughout the range complex prohibiting Marines from eating at the chow hall. Even the training that does occur on mainside does not always allow for Marines to stop during chow hall hours.
3. In addition to executing SLTE, in between SLTEs the Marines and Sailors of TTECG continuously conduct rehearsals, "dry runs" of ranges, range reconnaissance, fleet support, and other training that will at times, require them to be away from their normal workspaces, work outside of normal working hours, and through designated chow hall hours.
4. Per the requirement set by Reference (a), paragraph 4.a(2)(b)(2) stating that in order to qualify to receive COMRATS the service members' "work schedule would cause them to miss more than 30 percent of meals in the mess hall". It is recommended that all enlisted personnel attached or assigned to TTECG be afforded COMRATS.
