

# Intermediate MAGTF Logistics Operations Course

The IMLOC program of instruction advances student knowledge on the Marine Corps Planning Process, focusing on logistics, managing unit training and readiness, conducting operational planning and execution, and exercise design. The course produces expeditionary logistics instructors (ELIs)(AMOS: 0477), with an annual throughput of 144 SNCOs/Officers spanning all elements of the MAGTF and supporting establishment, that have developed the skills to thoroughly plan, design, schedule, conduct, and evaluate unit level training events and expeditionary planning. As trusted agents for their commanding officers, ELIs understand and can implement the art and science of readiness reporting drivers and methods for elevating unit readiness to meet all mission sets.

# Logistics Staff Training Exercises

The Logistics Staff Training Exercise (LSTX) is a MAGTF logistics staff exercise program. Unlike MCLOG's former BSTX, which focused solely on the staff of an LCE unit, the new LSTX focuses on logistics staffs from multiple MAGTF elements. The target population description of a MCLOG LSTX is the LCE commander and staff, and the logistics staffs from other elements of the MAGTF (CE, GCE, and ACE G4/S4 staffs). The LSTX therefore represents an evolutionary step in MCLOG's mission to train and educate well-rounded logisticians in the integration of logistics across the MAGTF.

# Expeditionary Logistics Seminars/Continuums

EXLOG is a collective training event designed to educate and train logisticians, who are preparing for deployment, on the full array of logistics capabilities that maybe needed to support the range of military operations. 
