Marines with Alpha Company, Headquarters Battalion, conducted a hike and shooting qualification on March 23. The event was held to foster camaraderie and reinforce the Marines’ readiness.

The hike, which was approximately six miles long, began at 3 a.m. at the Marksmanship Training Unit and took the Marines to the Obstacle Course before they returned to the MTU. After concluding the hike at the MTU, the Marines checked out weapons and received their brief prior to qualifying on tables 3 and 4.

Alpha Company is made up of Marines whose jobs are to support the training forces so it is imperative that they remain as current with their training.

“It is important for the Marines to combat condition and train, that is why we held the hike and range qualification all together,” said Capt. Robin Hixon, Alpha Company Commander, Headquarters Battalion. “A lot of the Marines haven’t had these kinds of camaraderie building events since initial training, so its beneficial for them.”

Even though some Marines struggled with the hike they stuck together. Having more than one hundred Marines, ranking from private to chief warrant officer, participating in the event gave the Marines an opportunity

Hornets fly ‘close’ missions for first time at EAF here

F/A-18 Hornets from Marine Corps Air Station, El Toro, Calif., will fly close-air support missions for the first time from the EAF during Combined Arms Exercise (CAX) 5-84, which starts Sunday. Along with other aircraft brethren from El Toro (A-4s and A6s), and helicopter support from MCAS Tustin and Camp Pendleton, Calif., the Hornets will provide support for Marine Infantrymen of 1st Battalion, 5th Marines, 1st Marine Division from Camp Pendleton.

The Ground Combat Element, the 1st Bn., 5th Mar., commanded by Lt. Col. R.G. Snyder will be attacking enemy simulated forces in the Delta Corridor, using live ordnance during three days and two nights of grueling live-fire action here. Maximum artillery support will be provided by the Combat Center’s 2d 8” Battery 4thBn., 11th Mar. Commander for the CAX forces is Col. L. E. Shaw of 5th Marines and controlling the air elements will be Lieutenant Colonel G. R. Vangysel

of Marine Aircraft Group-11, 3d Marine Aircraft Wing. Maj. M. R. Lehnert will be providing the critical combat support for the CAX forces by commanding Combat Service Support Detachment-16, 1st Force Service Support Group, also from Camp Pendleton. CAX 5-84 will conclude Tuesday and more than 2,000 Marines will be heading home to their coastal Southern California bases, having learned the finer art of mechanized combined-arms desert warfare training while using live ammunition.
