MARINE CORPS AIR GROUND COMBAT CENTER TWENTYNINE PALMS, Calif.- There will be an increase of military training noise in the Morongo Basin due to Marines and Joint Forces participating in a series of training events known as Service Level Training Exercise (SLTE) at the Combat Center Jan 20 - Mar. 1, 2024.

Noise from training may be amplified when the cloud cover is low. SLTE provides service-level assessments of units and their associated combat support, combat service support and aviation assets, while conducting live fire training focused on the mission essential tasks of offensive, defensive and stability operations.

Depending on atmospheric conditions, sounds from the training area may be amplified throughout the local area.
